2. g. am / ε' in (what remains of the eulachons after the grease is extracted) (ε ε k eulachon) ✓
3. gu x his' we' su "continually crazy", *na x noq* name. Before the guests entered the house, the performer attacked them and pulled their hair as if crazy. Later he assumed the name. ✓

1. na: bi' st "ripped" (the bladder of the bear)

1. g. am keegu' t "only dragged out" (the bear)
2. wi' am eski' tus "great turning over" (grizzly)

3. wi' det' u' ts "like dark" (about ~~the~~ walks bear)
