children of Ellsworth

- Dadens - the only large pole was carved by Edensia herself.  
- houses only 50 years old but rotting 1883  
50 1833

Chotki on E side of N.1.

"deceased before recall of E's grandfather

Connahaw, Em-yea &c = Gunya of Keen

Wakchaw - Connahaw = Black wood Gunna

"The original was Edensia's uncle" [which Edensia?]

Ellsworth skilled worker in gold & silver & carver in black slate.

Pole erected by Sqilao, uncle of AEE near beginning of 1800's

C Ed No 1  
uncle (Harjoifa) No 2

Pole erected by C Ed's uncle's uncle who succeeded  
Gunna as chief, at Dadens

Gunna's people - Stratas  
Kasawak's " - ialu

The present large pole at Dadens was owned by Kasawak  
though carved by CE's uncle.

Sqilao was No 3's uncle, town (?) chief at Hellen.

Carver was sqilt'ange, who died before AEE was born

did sqilao become Edenshaw and move to Keenata?

or did sqilao's nephew (No 3) do it?
