The beak of the grouse is curved like the fish trap.

2. k'isi' "one foot", a naxnɔq name. The performer hopped about on one foot.

3. ke' t'sap "red sky", naxnɔq name. A piece of leather painted red was used in the performance.

4. gamkciwe' "white man", a naxnɔq name recently adopted, when they saw the first white man. The performer wore a plug hat ~~and~~, pants and coat of the white man's costume, and wore a mask painted white.
Used by both men and women.

1. k'a x (without) "fat" (the grouse)

2. kse'q (have) "gone out" (the bear, in the spring)

Origin: from Kirgagas, house of ksangitgi'ge'nix
They separated from this house at Kirgagas.
