Performer got up on another man's shoulders and covered them both with a single cloak, to represent a very tall person.
2. kw̄q̄a'q "small raven", naxn̄g. The performer wore a black blanket over his head and impersonated the raven.
3. wi.sa'u.x "large coming out" (by grizzly)
The grizzly is large when it comes out of its ~~den~~ den
4. kwax̄t̄.p "eating small stones" (the grouse)
