We believe it is Thugit. a village ashore from Frederick Island
-- a stretch of sandy beach -- Tas la'nas sandy-village people
Chief si'ge (later had his hf at Masset) [220]

Harrison Ti ilaige near Sisk - most northerly village [?]

Deans Susk 1882 13 canoe loads of Kikkatlas & Tumnshians took up
1882 abode at Kleedo. poached sea otter, burnt houses. Much
prevented retaliation. 1883 Massets rebuilt. Want reserve
Kleedo 8 lodges 4 old 4 new want reserve


