A1: The exclusive hunting

territories of *Tris-talex*, and
royal *laxgiba*. The house has
since become extinct and now
used by the other Gin'adziks in
general and more especially the
laxgiba. The name of the territory
is derived from a river forming
a large valley which is called

{ *Ktsom-kadin*. The valley to the
in *okhsidraley* other side.

The whole of the Gin'adzik river
is a beaver colony the most fruit-
ful of all the Tsimshian hunting
grounds in this respect. also
berry grounds and marten are
caught here.

The royal house of *Tris-wexs*
Gispañiwada had no exclusive

⊗' gidzontk = secluded in secrecy but was a group of artists who were in the confidence of the tribe and made the carump used in the peacock society dances.

hunting territories among his 7 Gin'adsiks tribe and was taken in by any of his Gin'adsiks people, to their hunting grounds. The reason of this being, that originally the Hiwex's house came from Kittkaka, having come in flight owing to a feud and took refuge in the house of a former hide-man Hiaslut, who also was a Gispowindwada and when Hiwex's came among the Tsimshians and to the Gin'adsiks, from the Gitxaka he brought along much wealth, in the form of copper shields. Hiaslut also was a wealthy man and whose influence extended to the other tribes owing to his prestige as a gidzontk[⊗] man and was the foremost of his among these. Wishing to establish his fellow Gispowindwada as a royal house on the Gin'adsiks he done so. And the big distribution of wealth which he made with copper shields placed him as a royal house on the Gin'adsiks. Bearing in mind that he was of royal standing

at Kitkalk. But no exclusive 8
territories was given him ^{from} among
the Giraad'siks

B' - The hunting territory of the
Girpa-wad-wad known as Wol-sfo-lui
[Wheer-aer-aal-bee
or "Place where Alder grows".

It had been given this house by a
ganhada house of His-ga-ne's, as a
compensation for having given the
burial duties to a member of
the ganhada house of His-ga-ne's.
The fur bearing animals being
beaver, bear, marten, also berry
country and fishing, sockeye, cohoes,
hump and dog salmon, also fresh
water whitening (wits).

C The hunting territory of the
Iax-gibu group of Set-sai. The
whole territory being known as
Kitsam-nawairan.
{ inside distant valley.
C' This was the wolf village and

of the same name as the **Hunting**
Territory. This was used as was the
lake by all in common of this group.
Beaver, marten, mink & bear, and
all forms of salmon and berries.

D The Hunting Territory of
tsot-idnix ganhada. And was known
as lax-wotgiyaks
on where calm.

x D' A general fishing village where
all of the ganadnix fished and pre-
pared their salmon, just above the
rapids of the river. The village was
called lax-psa' : place of clay.

On the Territory, was caught
beaver, marten & mink & bear
also fishes. Also berry country
at the village lax-psa' there is a
Totem pole which belonged to Set'san

G' general village of all the Giniad's
 on the Skeena and called
 Giniad'siks. Also berry ground used by
 all in general and Salmon fishing
 station used by all in common.
 on the territory E, beaver, marten
 fisher, mink and bear abound.
 also herring.

F Was a territory used exclusively
 by the house of Xpi-lap which
 was known as Kna-ds'
 other side.

This was acquired by a former
 Xpi-lap from the Gildzan.

as compensation from them for
 general duties. The group Xpi-lop
 being extinct on the grounds the
 rights have been taken by the Sefiant
 group of Iaxgibu.
