

Bishop - re Comewa

p 121 Sept '95 at Notha, from Barnett of "Mercury."

Capt Moore ^{his boat} was attacked while watering at Comewa and one man killed. Capt Moore hauled in the ship close to the village and fired on the Natives which they returned so smartly that they were glad to get out again."

p 122 Mercury & another ship sailed to Comewa to redeem Sailer. Sailer Scatts Eye the chiefs brother, his family, and a son of Comewa - several natives killed.

July '94 Schooner of Boston 11 men anchored at Comewa instantly overwhelmed

p 122-6

Went in June (95) with Comewa in 11 armed canoes to fight Skeet-e-skeetes a tribe a little to the north of here. -- here on beach - muskets prohib-
daggers and spears 11 dead Comewa side, 8 on other
Comewa retired leaving 8 wounded prisoners [+ 11 dead]
