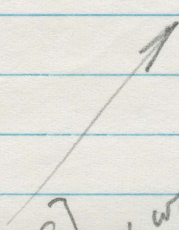

acc. 823 Doctor's Rattle. (Description of how made)

"The rattle sent was made by Solomon Gwegwan' / ŋ, son of the last Edensa. It is a copy of the rattle used by his uncle, Haka / i, a well known doctor of Kiuste, who is buried at Kūñ. The design on one side is the salt water eagle tca gūñ ōt, on the other side the salt water beaver tca gūñ teiñ.

Chupo's rattle

(Seso of Tamsian)

(Give story of Tām chief Tamsiŋks no China Hat, a Bitkunaks story - later saw a bird swimming in the sea, long beak (tci kide kidegete, koduñ Masset) Assoc with Wilalla - Ramatea)

"The large bird forming the rattle is a raven living in the sea, tca gūñ hoyā, on its breast is the hawk Skiamson, nearly ornamental; on the back of the raven is wilalla with long tongue reaching to the beak of the bird, tci kida or King-feather. (As told by Chief Edensa of Massett)."°

"at Hielen old Edensen's uncle lived who as a boy saw
Douglas. his uncle's name was Eunia."

10 fathoms across, 7-6 being smallest.

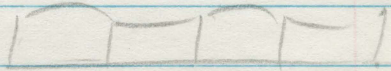

Slate dish No 17952 refers Nankilistlas in the act of collecting
women's quarrel on the first rock which appeared in the Haida
Country. This was in the far south. Up to that time the
only people were men. N speared the parts & threw them
at the men so that they landed on their parts, making them
so ashamed that they ran away and hid. Because they
grew up so quickly. Raven is seen with his cloak of
feathers and is steered by a man made of the Tlingit
called wood brescut. Dish made by C Edmea

"The designs like Killer & Bear etc seen on Chieft
blanket boxes are not crests & can be used by either
Rav. or Eagle families. Valued solely for the carving."
