"...there were formerly two or three other places where Haidas were resident on the west coast of the islands.... A village was situated on the island called Hippa by Dixon, of which the Haida name was, I believe, <u>Mus-too</u>. Dixon gives a sketch... Hippah....

p. 171. "The last village of which I have any knowledge, stood formerly on or very near Frederick Island of the maps. Its name, or that of the island, was <u>Susk</u> or <u>Sisk</u>. It is reputed to have been populous, but may never have been very important.
