Laxskik history.

gispaxlsts:-

The first chief of this tribe was *lə'ət*, a gispaw. who had moved from Tamlaham to *ksədzəx* on the Nass. Later, *waxa'i.t* (also gisp) became head chief and *lə'ət* became secondary.

xpi.lak (Laxskik) became chief, as *waxa'i.t* didn't have the wealth to maintain his position. (At first, AW says *xpi.lak* came long before the *ni.swa'amak* gunhoot. Later, he said that they came at same time. But *xpi.lak* seems to have a different story:-) From Tamlaham originally, they had drifted north to Alaska in the flood. They fought among themselves because of a woman who was married to an Eagle and had another Eagle as lover, and some fled south to *nē'e* (identified as Kasan on map, on other side of Port Chester). At *nē'e* they fought with some tribe over fishing rights, and split up (now in mixed groups): some to Nass, some to Alaska, some to Skuna; some got as far south as Kitimat. *xpi.lak* was head of the Skuna group, which eventually settled at Metlakatla, (and became head of gispaxlsts. Subdivs: 1 *xpi.lak*
2 *tkwil·axe'*
3 *wut'a'g.əp*
4 *ni'sne'.x*

ni.swa'amak: When the gunhoot came they did not have this name. *ni.swa'amak* was a nephew of *xpi.lak*, created a chief to ^(now created then too)succeed him as he was the wealthiest. The other branches of *xpi.lak*'s house still retained their royalty, and after *ni.swa'amak*'s death, *xpi.lak* again became head chief.

legex

ni-spele's was a gwunhoot who had an independent house since Alaskan days. He was of royal rank, but below xpi.luk and ni.swamak. He was a head chief of the qispaxlts between waxait and ni.swamak. Only wul-e'isk to ni.swamak. When legex came he amalgamated with this house.

Rank of royal chiefs when legex came:

1. legex (ni-spele's)
2. ni.swa''amak
3. xpi.luk
4. ka'anak (of 2.)
5. gastu>ini (of 2.)

legex came from wudste. In former times the qispaxlts had a battle and the mother of legex went over to Kitimat. From there she married to wudste, and legex was her son. When he had grown up, he was taunted and told the direction to ^{his} grandfather's land. Taking some wudste funds with him, he came to Metlakatla, was recognized as royal laxskik, and was taken into house of ni-spele's. On the death of the chief, ni.swa''amak, he became chief.

sg.agwet:

In former times legex was the chief of three groups, the git'ands', the gitwilksabe' and the qispaxlts. sg.agwet was a boy's name in the house of legex. He was only adopted by the git'ands' as their chief when the Tsimshian moved permanently to Port Simpson.
