15.230. Deer, salmon, rorts, bernes were staples. Deer was more important to the upper division, while salmon was the principal food of the lower division.

Salmon: Fraser flentiful every year - king salmon cured hings scarce on Thompson, where soekeys run every 4th year in large numbers
