The principal objectives of the First Citizen's Fund, as stated by the Honourable Dan Campbell, are

"To contribute support to projects involved with the advancement and expansion of the culture, education, economic circumstances, and position of persons of the North American race who were born in and are residents of the Province of British Columbia."

We propose to make an analysis of the First Citizen's Fund, our main concern being to discover whether or not this fund provides beneficial financial aid to Indian peoples in British Columbia.

Firstly, we are separately analysing the schedule of allocations for June 15, 1969 to March 31, 1971 and April 1, 1971 to June 30, 1972. To discover whether there have been any significant changes between the two schedules, in the areas where funds have been granted, we have organized the schedules into the following categories: culture, education, recreation, communications, position of persons, area development and surveys and economic assistance.

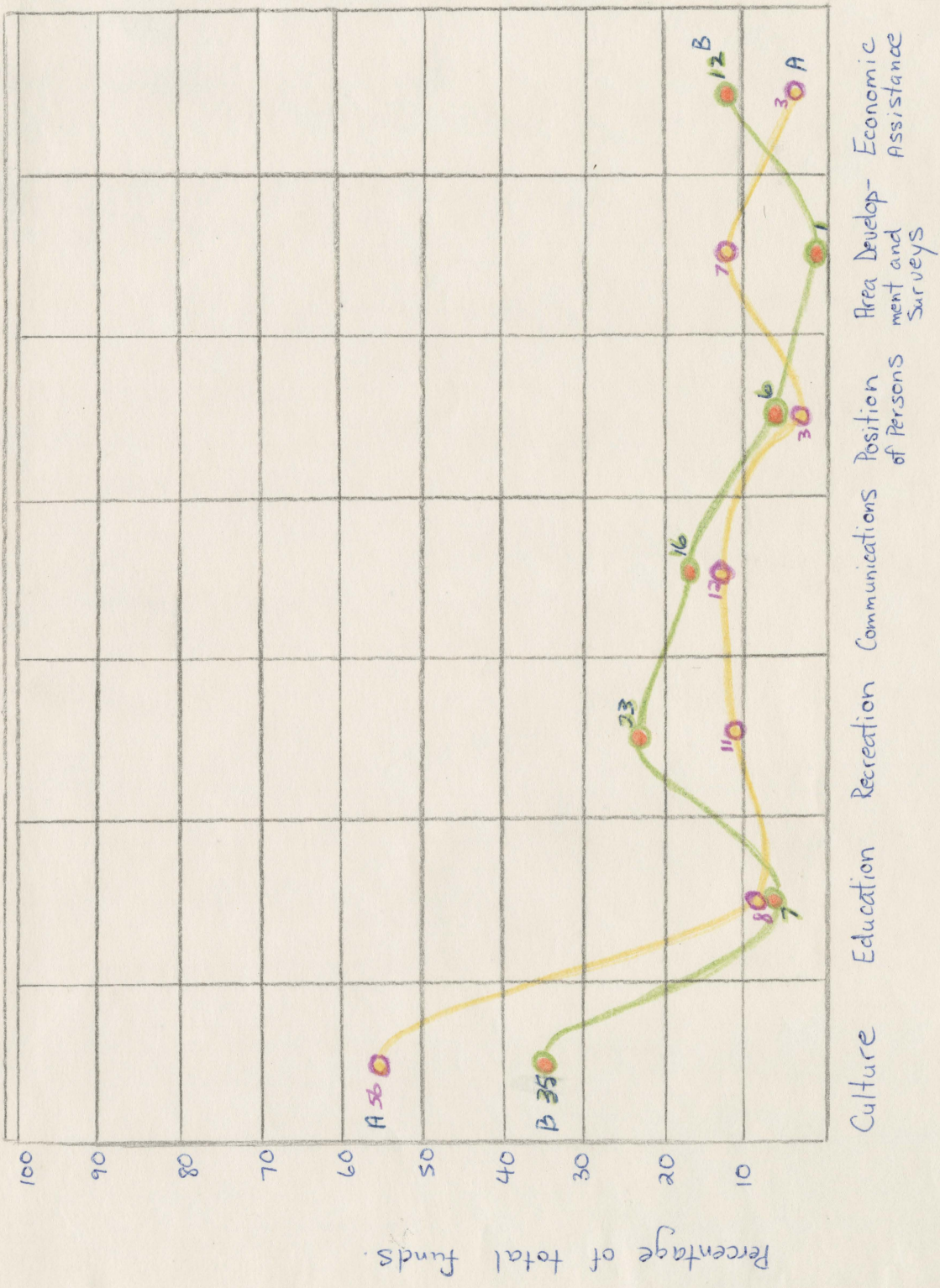

Conclusions

The graph we have included shows a marked decrease in funds for culture. at the same time there has been an increase in funds for recreation and economic assistance.

The First Citizen's Funds Policy is not to "support or to replace existing programmes financed through the Department of Indian Affairs, Canada, nor to displace existing programmes financed under any other department of the Government of the Province of British Columbia".

This therefore accounts for the fact that the areas of Area Development and Surveys and Education have obtained minimal funds. One of the First Citizens Funds Project policies is that

"consideration will be given to projects involving in-service training where the fund would pay the salary of native Indians being trained in municipal and provincial government offices in order that the Indian might learn special skills on the job."

These in-service training programmes, which we have categorized under Position of Persons have received only 3 and 6 percent, ^{representations} consecutively, of the total funds. We feel that political and economic stability are necessary in order that Indian people can develop strong national unity. We think that

stability can only come about through the training of Indians in special skills, in order that they can represent themselves in their own affairs. The reason for minimal funds for in-training programmes could be due to either the fact that the First Citizens Fund has refused to make many grants in this area or that few requests by the Indians themselves have been made.

One of the problems concerning the First Citizens Fund is that the more remote villages in British Columbia are not aware of the existence of the fund and that it is relatively easy to procure grants. What is needed is a representative to circulate informative material to these villages about the fund.

We feel that the fund is beneficial because it allows Indians to choose for themselves in which areas they want to allocate funds. We feel that funds should not be designated at the federal level but rather, that the decision-making power should be in the hands of the community.
