1. Enumerated in Fraser River (or New Westminster) Agency 1881 to 1917, in Vancouver Agency in 1929, 1939, 1954.
2. Census figures given for 1895 and some years previous are too high. The superintendent wrote in 1896 - "There is a decrease of eight hundred and forty seven...this year...[in whole agency] owing to the fact that I have been able to obtain an accurate census..." (1896 Report, p.88). I have made estimates.
3. Census figures of 1900 and some years previous for Sliammon are too high. The superintendent wrote in 1901: "In previous years a number of Indians belonging to Sechelt, Klahoose and Homalko, and who were intermarried with Sliammon Indians, had been enumerated by mistake twice". (1901 Report, p.241). I have estimated 100 outsiders.
4. 1895 and previous counts of Squamish seem to be about 400 too high. See fn.2 above. I assume 400 Squamish.
