1. All enumerated starting 1881 in Lower Fraser (New Westminster) Agency. In 1911 the upriver group was transferred to the Lytton Agency, and enumerated there 1915, 1917, 1929, and 1939, but in 1954 this group was enumerated in New Westminster Agency. In 1929 and thereafter, Musqueam was enumerated in Vancouver Agency.

2. Seabird Island was inhabited by 1890 but not counted in the census until 1915. I assume 100 residents as early as 1896, for totalling purposes. (Proceedings of Reserve Commission, Lytton Agency, p.375).

3. 1896 figures are used as the superintendent considered them more accurate.
