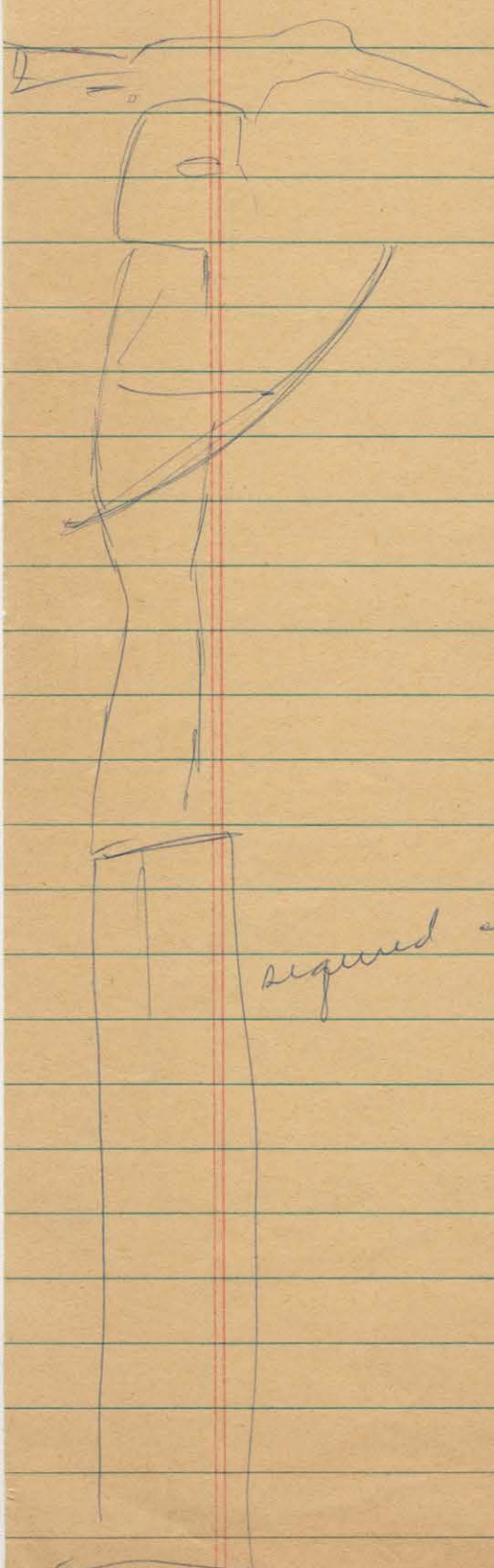

2. Single human face below row of children - Tsiwiladaw, ancestress that adopted wood-pecker as a pet
3. Next large person - Split-person
