

XI House of dzayamgisha'itks

(g. anha'da)

Mens names

(1) dzayamgisha'itks

dzayamgisha'itks = gan'am ktsimaos
towards shore moves standing of snay of

"the snay of ktsimaos moves closer to shore"

(2) dzayam yilye'ltk

dzayam yilye'ltk = 'natkutkat - next
towards returning of offspring of blackfish
"the offspring of blackfish returns to shore"

(3) dzowil'aks ancient gitxa'la term

(4) 'antasa'da'axs "box of tools for making a da'ax house",
a naxnax name; when assumed, the person holds
a box supposedly containing implements for making an
excavated house. When his name is called he empties the box.

(5) basam ganao "frightened frog"

(6) we's "rain" a watsta slave belonging to this house
returned from hunting in a downpour of rain, and the his
water-streaked face led them to call him "rain". The name
was never redeemed and remained in this house.

(7) dzaxdzaxk "itching", a naxnax name; the person
is dressed as though covered with itching sores, which he
scratches until he dies, then a medicine man sings his
song and revives him.

(8) gaiyamsedet

gaiyamsedet wimedisk

nearly sits the large grizzly
"the large grizzly bear sits nearby."

(9) g. amga/dzadzao "only empty foreigner", a naxnax
represented as foreign ~~native~~ Indian who dies and
then returns to life as a gitxa'la.

(10) h̥̥n̥m n̥ext

wih̥n̥at̥ ḡ̥na n̥e̥x̥t̥ n̥ext̥

many of the fins of blackfish

"the blackfish has many fins"

(11) do̥z̥atsk̥am n̥e̥x̥t̥

do̥z̥atsk̥am n̥e̥x̥t̥ ḡ̥nat̥k̥ut̥k̥at̥ n̥ext̥

black fin of the offspring of blackfish

"the offspring of black fish has a black fin"

(12) t̥xḁa l̥ɔ̥'tk̥

t̥xḁa l̥ɔ̥'tk̥at̥ ḡ̥net̥k̥ut̥k̥at̥ n̥ext̥

all ready floating the offspring of blackfish

"the offspring of blackfish is all ready floating"

(13) t̥kuq̥it̥'ands̥ "small git'ands̥" anax̥n̥x̥ name.

A slave was taken from a high ranking git'ands̥ family. The git̥xḁta gave him this name ~~at~~ at a secret society performance which re-enacted the battle, to ridicule the git'ands̥ and show the valour of the git̥xḁta.

upstream ^{more} noona of offspring of blackfish

"the offspring of blackfish moves upstream"

(2) g.č̄is

sa g.čidaks̄at n̄atkutk̄at next
sudden appearing of offspring of blackfish

"the offspring of blackfish appears suddenly"

(3) g.aodakne'ęx

g.aodakne'ęx at n̄atkutk̄at next

notched fin of offspring of blackfish

"the offspring of blackfish has a notched fin"

(4) wiñe'ts "large dear man"

(5) xts̄adao

xts̄daot n̄ene'ęx next

half frozen the fin of blackfish

"the fin of blackfish is half frozen"

(6) wa'als a gitga'ata name?

(7) l̄emx

l̄ayač̄lemdzič̄ at n̄atkutk̄at gibeo
each side enters of offspring of wolf

"the offspring of wolf enters at each side"

(8) gikne'itsk "again dear man" (The child had done
something wrong and was pardoned).

(9) po'ok

biyenamb̄ot next

smoke spouting blackfish

"the spout of blackfish is like smoke"

Womens names

- (1) 'ntsists g̓wəl̓ax̓s "grandmother of g̓wəl̓ax̓s (a Haida slave)"
- (2) wisiqidam'nyam k̓sam̓wa'yin a ridicule name.
big chief woman woman of lower class
a woman of this house once married the chief n̓is̓st̓k̓ux̓s against the wishes of the people. They gave her this name to humiliate her for aspiring to become a chief woman, and her house at once called a feast and took the name to put a stop to the ridicule.

- (2) wiboo' wiboot na tkutkat 'next large spouting of the offspring of blackfish
- (3) 'nukst̓t̓a 'nat k̓ut k̓at 'next agiyaks towards floating the offspring of blackfish out to sea
"the offspring of blackfish floats out to sea"
- (4) beto' betam̓t̓t̓ nat k̓ut k̓at 'next spread out float the offspring of blackfish
"the offspring of blackfish swims spread out"
- (5) dzayamda'ks dzayamda'ks t̓ nat k̓ut k̓at xs̓k̓idk̓ towards shore splashes of the offspring of eagle
"the offspring of eagle splashes on water towards shore"

(6) hagi^ox^t name of a character in a myth.

large nest of the offspring of eagle

"the offspring of eagle has a large nest"

(8) g^alk^sag^aya^m n^ex^t

g^alk^sag^aya^m n^ex^t ^onetkut^kat ^one^xt

through hole fin of the offspring of blackfish

"the offspring of blackfish has a hole through its fin"

(9) hoⁿs

gam x^pil x^b>nt^kat ^onetkut^kat x^ski^ak

only across salmon of the offspring of eagle

"the offspring of eagle comes across to partake of salmon"

(10) se^onlu[']at^ks

se^onlu[']at^ksat ^onetkut^kat x^ski^ak

building nest of the offspring of eagle

"the offspring of eagle builds its nest"

(11) x^pil gana[']at^ks

x^pil gana[']at^ks at ^onatkut^kat x^ski^ak

across shrike of offspring of eagle

"the offspring of eagle comes over to shrike"
