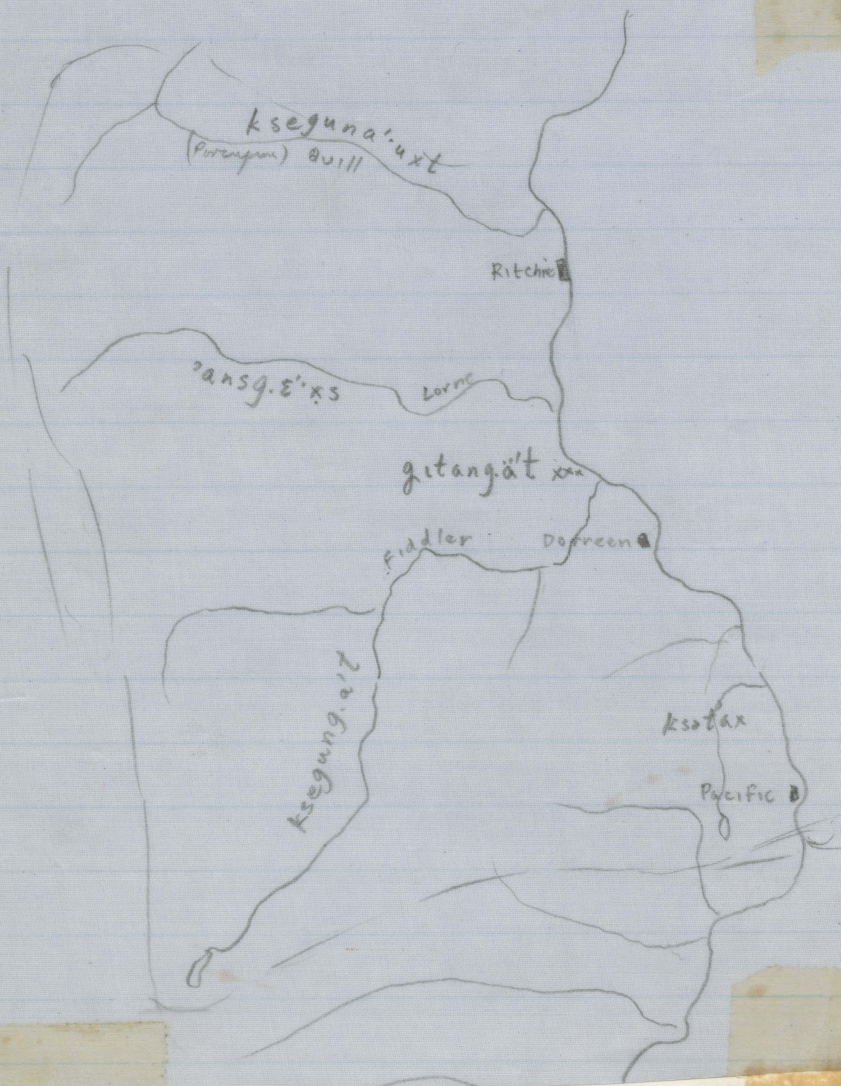
laxskik

All the laxskik shared the same territories

- ① The main territory was down the river in the vicinity of the former village of git'ang.ɛ't, from whence they came.

It started downriver at ksət'ax "water from lake", included ksegung.a't (Faddlers Creek) and to ɣansɣ.ɛ'xs (Lone Cr.) to their headwaters, and ended upriver at kseguna'uxt "waters where porcupine" (Porcupine or Quill Cr)



- ② win lumit'anda'wil "fire burning inside quiver" (from an incident when a fire started here from some trader yu'lux in a quiver), the mountain south of Kitwanga. qəq uses it for hunting, goes back 50 miles. There is no conflict

with guxsan, the ground is on the other side
of that mountain.

That place belonged to laxse'l before, to
the house of wistis. A man from wistis
house married a woman of house of qsq,
and they had a son. The man said his
son would take his place as heir, beginning
with this hunting ground. There has often
been trouble over this ground. wistis family
wanted to take it back. wistis is still
using this place but qsq is angry with him.
