

2. Bucktrout a bit Treaty No. 8 1899 pp 70-71

- a regular Canadian Treaty, as settlement progressed across Canada.
- NWT Alberta & E British Columbia. (St John & St Mary)
- Terms uniform (p. 71)
- Beavers 1900 Klavos 1910
- still doubtful how much area it covers

Significance:

- precedent of Dominion recognizing and paying for Indian Title to BC lands

- I think it should follow its precedent and proceed to negotiate Treaty No. 12. BC Treaty " 1921 NWT

- only fair and equitable way to extinguish native title

- only way used in the past
