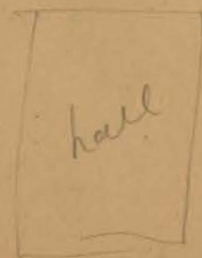

1. old hollow fallen 36' pole. Far gone. Bottom 2 frogs are large humans. Then 7 small humans across, upside down etc. Then 2 more upright.
2. Tall pole. Eagle on top, plain, fish painted on front, eagle, human with hole in tummy. Round carved back.
3. Flying frog in marble. "Chief Widakaky's gu. Died Mar. 1912. Aged 70 years."
3. Bear, plain, human. Round back.
4. Whale with human on back, same below, with human in mouth. Hollow back.
5. old door post. Hollow back. 2 humans w/ eagle above door hole.
6. Tall pole, hollow back. Eagle, human, eagle, beaver, human, 2 squirrel, human.
7. Sea Bear, bear, seabear, wolf, seabear. Doorpost. hollow back.
8. wolf, bear, 2 sea bears, man holding wolf.
9. ugly modern pole.
- 9a. Good pole. Hawknoze? 2 frogs, man.

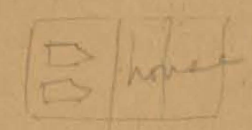
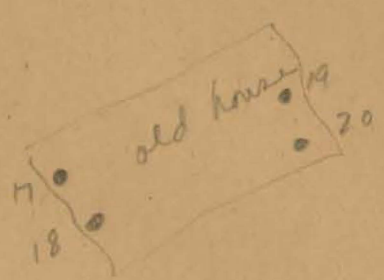
