Peter Kelly is descended from the Narkunkigawai of Rose Spit (He is the last, and bears the name $\lambda a \text{ } \text{3} \text{ } \eta \text{ } k' u \text{ } n a$)
wave very large

The Narkun people (ravens) split over a dispute between brothers. Half moved first to Cape Ball and settled. Intermarried with Skidegates. Chief Skidegate invited them to settle in Skidegate and gave them the north half of the village site (north of road up to church).

{ Kinstinta people moved in next
Church Creek " " " " - they had earlier come from
Maude Isl. " " " " -
West Coast and set up village of New Gold Harbour.

There was no division of the village site for these later people. They just "opened up" and gave them places to build their houses.
