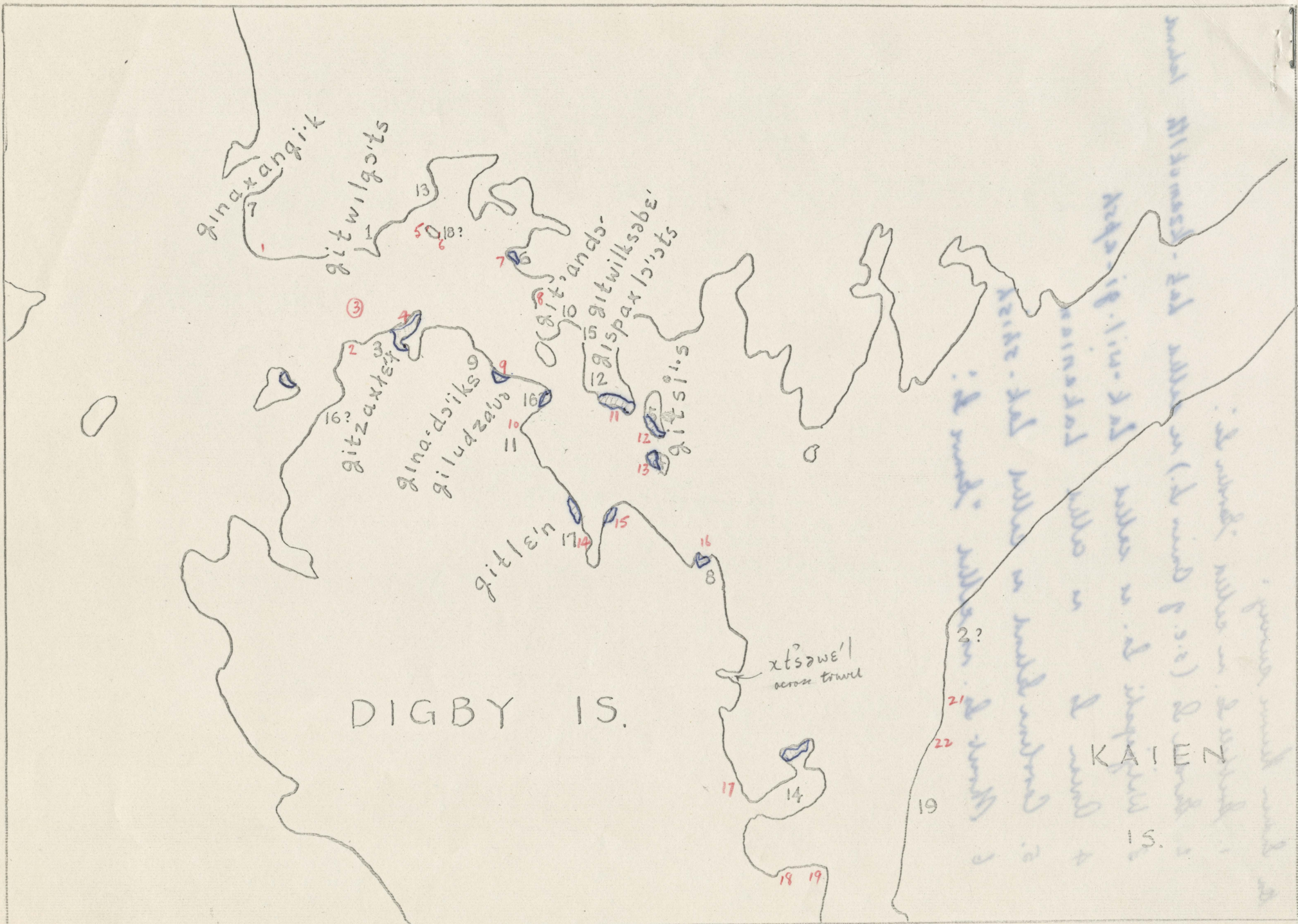


ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES AT METLAKATLA

The base map is that of "Tsimshian Villages at Metlakatla". Information from two sources has been added: first, the archaeological sites listed by Drucker (Archaeological Survey on the Northern Northwest Coast, Figure 1), shown in red; and second, some names and marked sites (clearings? middens?) shown on the map of the original Indian Reserve survey.

The Reserve Survey map uses some names different from those on present maps (eg. Prince Rupert 1:50,000 103J8 west half):

1. Present Gribbell Island was called "Garden Island".
2. Present Garden Island was called Lak-kzamuklth Island.
3. Present Shrub Island was called Grave Island.
4. Wilgiapshi Island was called Lak-wil-gi-apsh.
5. Anian Island was called Lakanian.
6. Carolina Island was called Lak-shish.

On Indian Kewee survey:

1. Gubbell Is. is called "Garden Is".
2. Garden Is (s.e. of Anian Is.) is called Lak-kzamuklth Island
3. Wilgiapshi Is. is called Lak-wil-gi-apsh
4. Anian Is. is called Lakanian
5. Caroline Island is called Lak-shish
6. Thoub Is. is called "Kewee Is".

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
