casket arrived from Obilla.



Also Victoria

He gave her long list of royal names,
and she took a long time, but chose
Isabella. He asked Mr H what Queens
were - He got pictures. She said "that
is the way we'll dress from now on"

Abalone - Florence says definitely CE
got his supply from Victoria
(R.D. thought from up in Alaska)

R Davidson's name is gunia
he says it is a Tlingit name

He says Tian and some other place
names on NW c Graham are Tlingit
names, meaning "early people were".

Says canoe landed stern first,
because  bow caught on beach,
and  stern better shape.

Henry (son of AEE) had a hotel, where
Florence worked 'for her uncle'
he bought things from CE for resale
profit? "I guess so"

Boxes - In late years (after Florence married RD)
RD Davidson made boxes which CE painted
them often small (9"?)
Before, CE made own boxes and
painted them
- take about 3 days to paint a box
liked lace-like design (cross hatching)
and called it $\text{Egw} \partial' n$ / č'ika
skunkcabb head
yellow
head has xxx design on it
("rope" (groundorning)
called "rope" in Haida.

Languages -

CE spoke to CFN in Chinook
" a little English
" Tl. & Tsims

AEE also spoke Tl, Ts, a little English

Gold? he did lots of gold
during 1913 --- he couldn't keep up with
orders ---
lots of gold

CE. son died at 18, in 1895
died August Florence born Sept.

so born

She says he painted furniture. Doesn't remember
patterns on his box. When she painted a
canoe on the 'Boe, she used patterns

Supply of slate

During his time he used to buy it. Also
his nephew at Skid. got it for him. They
went each spring by canoe to Skidegate
around Rose Spit.

Earlier, when he was young and his
mother was alive, he spent whole summers
at Skidegate. Lot of time at Skidegate

Didn't seem to know of trail from Masset
("I guess no")

HEE lived for 2 yrs at Ft Simpson
did not work in slate or silver or gold
did all kinds of work in wood
totem poles, etc

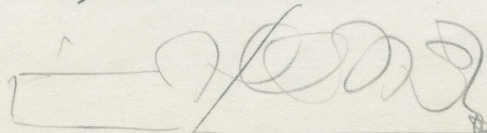
Only a few canoe makers (RD)
" " " painted boxes

That was how he made his living
"but he also enjoyed it"

Canes she thinks CE ^{invented them} was only one who
made them, (esp with ivory beads)
CFN brought elephant tusks
CE used chips to inlay slate things
ivory inlay

Someone asked him if he traced designs -
he said no - freehand.

yes, he made

CE worked every day - 'like a hobby'

When he didn't have jewellery orders he worked on slate

never saw him miss a day

Exc. Sunday - no work (not even firewood)

- special clothes
- they prepared for Sunday

CE made own paint brushes

- horse tail hair

- cut at angle

"he always used his own brushes, ~~was~~
never bought --

Paint - made his own

- had stone pot, rubbed pigment in until thick enough

- washed it green right away so could mix other color

Only 3 colors: red si'i't

green
black
