- (1) gushawε'.l "robe of war", a crest of this house.
A robe of elk skin covered with arrows.
- (2) gusgalie "robe of scalps(?)"
- (3) 'εmε'xs

(4) guldzedzε't

guldzedzεt εt natkutkət xskləkət g.abit
quickly eating of the offspring of eagle its food
"the offspring of eagle quickly eats its food"

- (5) 'a hɔ' : a saltwater bird. A naɣnɔx name; the person imitated the actions and cry of this bird and would be "killed" by the hala'it, then restored to life again.

Boys names

- (1) gwili

- (2) 'nε'n

- (3) βəl'ək for βəl'əkwe' "down (feathers)" used in headdress worn when one chief welcomed another in a spirit of friendliness; also used by a house prep-aring for war, it would be made to issue through the smoke hole.

(4) maxtagipak

maxtagipak εt natkutkət xsklək g.ilhaoli
over flying of offspring of eagle on hill
"the offspring of eagle flies over the hill"

(5) baxgobel

baxgobelat naktkat gibeo agilhaoli

^{up} ^{hill} two of the offspring of wolf on hill

"the offspring of wolf go up the hill in twos"

sayait hayetskat ktkat gex

alltogether copper of offspring ravens

"the offspring of raven have a copper all together"

(2) wel's

dzayam wilwelat natkutkat xskiak

towards shore where done the offspring of eagle

"the offspring of eagle flye towards shore"

(3) paiks

sayait gipaikat xskiak agantak

alltogether flying of eagles in the morning

"the eagles fly all together in the morning"

(4) 'ataxsgexs

'ataxsgexsat natkutkat gex agantak

early cawing of the offspring of raven in the morning

"the offspring of raven caws early in the morning"
