Dear Professor:

Thank you for your letter of January 14, 1974, a.d.

in my letter of November 3rd. 1973, A.D. I notice that I made a big mistake by writing "300.00", it should be \$3000.00 and not \$300.00.

Since you desire to get more details, I have revised the plan as follows after I consult one of the KASAN people.

10. Mrs Abel Campell (Negeeds-angwaks)

These elders would help each other and put things together as far as they can remember; each would get \$5.00 per hour teaching younger pupils; each session may be 3 Or 4 hours would cost 200.00 therefore; in other words ten sessions would cost 2000.00 dollars or twenty sessions would cost \$4000.00.\*

ten students 3 Or 4 hour each session( each getting \$3.00 per hour incentive) would amount to \$120.00 per session; twenty students \$240.00. therefore, ten sessions of ten students would amount to \$1200.00; twenty sessions of of ten students would amount to \$2400.00. or ten sessions of twenty students would amount to \$2400.00 or twenty sessions of twenty students would amount to \$4,800.00\*incentives

On the other hand ,we may call to do the recording if absolutely necessary; kindly include the cost of a very strong tape recorder with tapes in additon to the approximate costs shown above.

If the estimation above appears to inadequate, kindly do what you can on the application forms which I have signed herewith enclosed.

The cost of ~~salvaging~~ salvaging a sunken ship, or whatever ~~could~~ be salvaged, is always costly but we cannot aford the cost that is the reason we are very anxious that the application may be accepted.

In my first letter, I indicate that we would start on the first week of January, but now the people will son be scattered to work some ~~part~~ place else and the applicatio procedur~~as~~ well as other procedur~~es~~would take time, therefore if our application is accepted I suggest that we start in October 1974; there will be several classes of songs, say welsome songs for other chiefs who invites the Kitwancool chiefs, Peace songs, lamentaion songs; War peace songs; Divorce songs as far as we can remember.

feel that we may take appropriate action.

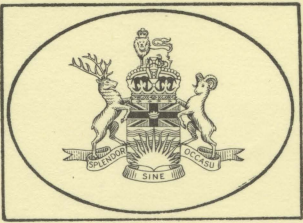
We may retain a good lawyer to guide us properly in the matter and before Both

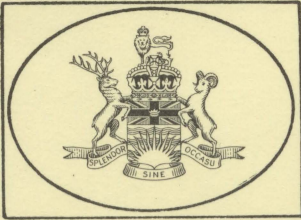
