Eg one type: cross-phrastic (child → adult names)

1. lu x on in eat salmon

lu x sin om tsem an lo'k x ski-k
in eating salmon in where nest of eagle

Eagle eating salmon in its nest [indicates Fas phrastic.]

F₃ 2. ni' g'anks "on sunshine" (Sunbeams)
on sunshine - (on the fin of the killer whale)

sunshine glinting on the wet fin of the emerging killer whale
(on the white head of Eagle)

3. tsem gwanks
in spring bright where sets the Frog

(frog sitting in a shaft of sunlight in a spring of water)

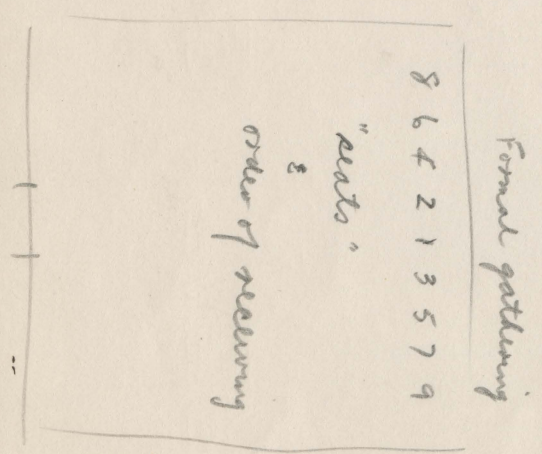
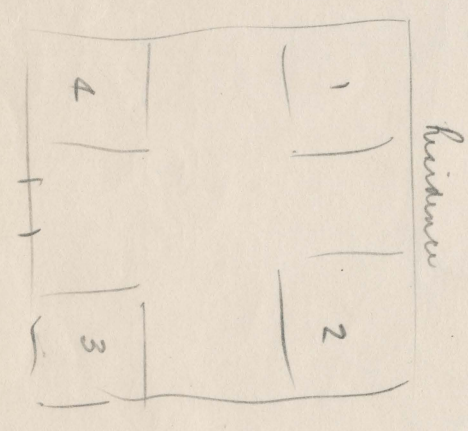
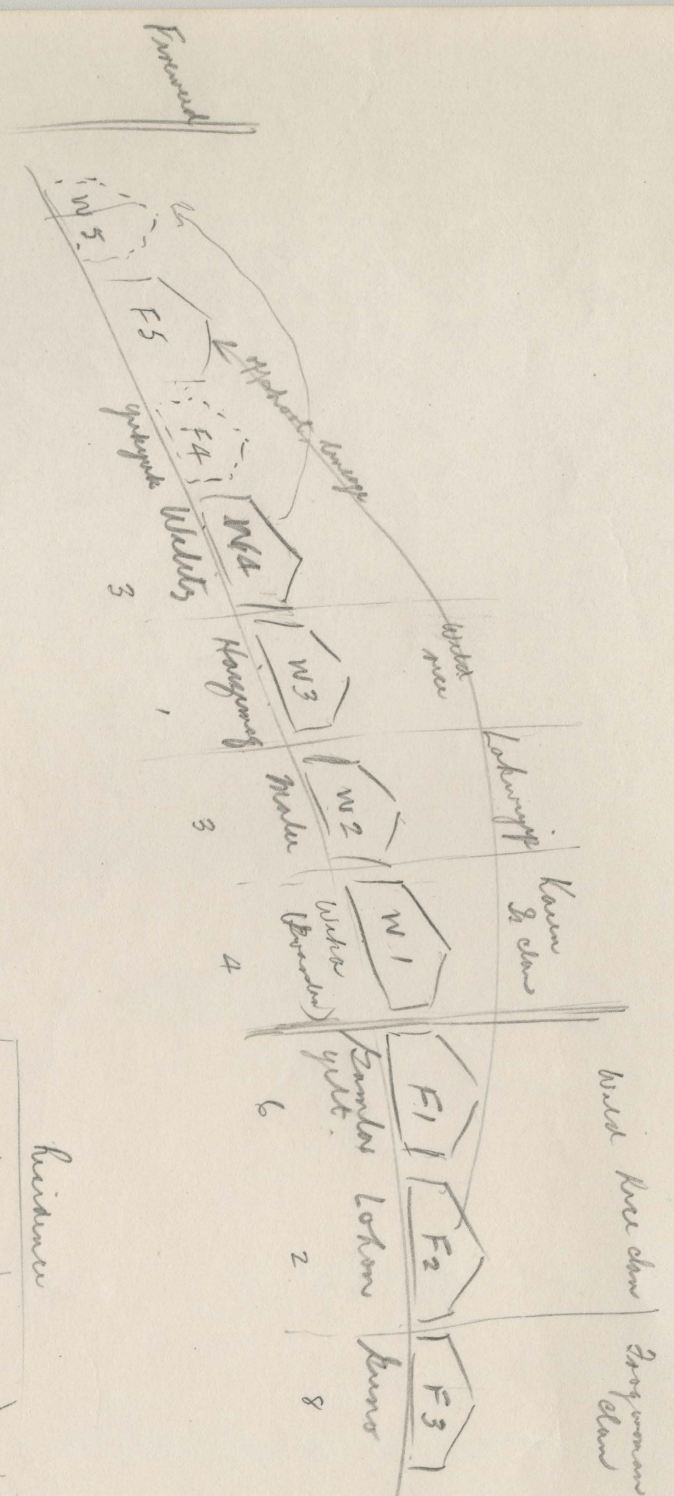
