Crests: 1. leg'in'su standing bear on pole, fallen pole on old village site here.

2. g'ibo - robe

Ans. Orygen: Lemlaham. The name of spɔg was given this house by spɔx (Zaimshian). g'ibe'o is the former head of the house.

Hel: 1. nislaganos of Kitwancool, same crests, adaox

Crests 1. t'amsmax sitting bear, on pole (the third pole from village); two bears repres. in his house here in g, tən maks on 4 corner posts.

naxnɔg 2. g'ibe'o - as a naxnɔg, not crest.

Ed. Clarke: helatwis: 1. sgat'in (qitlaxdamks.)
(spɔx) 2. spɔx (g'ispax to ts)

Orygen: qitang.a'sx "people of wild rice", up the river sqansnat is the name of his hunting ground, away up the Kiepiox about 25 miles above.

Crests 1. hetxum smax standing bear
2. Kibu wolf - whole skin, with its head over his head.

3. 'wayiwɔ', meaning qagɔn smax open bear. A great bear on a pole at the door to the first house. It opened to allow each guest to come through.
