Early British Policy - recognizing native title, treaty, compensation

Royal Proclamation - 1763 - reserving western Brit No. Am
as Indian territories

- specifying that Indians could only sell at
to Crown - by treaty

(still in force)

Governor Douglas 1850-54 Treaties (still in force)

RESERVES WITH TREATIES

trying to apply proper British policy.

1860 - failure to get money for Cowichan treaty

- RESERVES WITHOUT TREATIES

1864-1871 Later Colonial governors

- denied Indian title

- no more reserves
