1. wi·mənɔ·zək "large wolverine", a naxn̄q name.
The performer, dressed in a mask and fur, impersonated this animal.
2. kwɔ·gɑ'q "small raven", naxn̄q name
3. gɛ'nux "drowsy", naxn̄q. The performer acted drowsy, and whenever way he would lean the rest of his house would follow suit.
4. 'axqalq.a'n "careless", naxn̄q.
5. sag.alinɛ's wamq.an name
6. 'maстsa'q "white nose" wamq.an name
7. lu·gedəm tsəmanla'ku "person of the fireplace" a person in fire a naxn̄q name.
The performer was made to appear suddenly out of the fireplace as the fire burned.
8. tsuwe'. wamq.an name
9. sag.apwaxg.zl.t "careless person in front of village" a naxn̄q.

Boys

1. *lɪg-i-ná-pt* "about going" (the offspring of the grizzly)
2. *wɪx-sɔx-tɔ'-tu* "big out coming" (sun)
Great sunrise
3. *gɪsax'-ɛ'-tu* "down to the river calling itself" (the wolf)
4. *tax'-ɛ-txəm-tɛ'-qu* "itself calling after eating" (the wolf)
5. *laχ'-lu-wi'-ləs* "on both sides sounds" (the thunder)
6. *luxti'ns* "in five" (bears, with cubs, in the den)

Women

1. 'yε'-t "warrior" or "brave one", a naxnqg name. The performer, though a woman, carries a double ended dagger (tag-a-x-wa'n) and impersonates a brave man.
2. xtāg.ε'-su "strongly squatting", a naxnqg.
3. ku'na'ks "quarrelling", a naxnqg name. The performer provoked quarrels with the guests.
4. xsəm w>g.εtu' "woman of great distance" ^{far away} naxnqg. The woman performer carried a pack of the products of a distant place.

Girls

1. lu'tqa'isu "in attacking" (bear)
The bear attacks from in its den
2. dəpxadəm səg.ε'xs "two swimming" (large grizzlies)
3. ya.g. amit'ms'-t "down from the hill, the growing of pups" (of the wolf)
4. lu'tqa'lpx "in four" (bears, with cubs, in the den)
5. gux>w>'.x "to stay barking" (the wolf)
6. tqa'lāpu (never) "trapping" (the wolf).
(To catch a wolf in a trap is an omen of bad luck.)

7. *kicicu's* "small" (trails, large grizzly)
 The young grizzlies make small trails beside
 that of the large grizzly.
8. *sag.ətluqə'px* "all together or trapped"
 (in the den, the large grizzlies)
9. *yag.aqisqitə* "downwards move" (the
 snows, on the mountain)

refers to negt myth. Tongue protruding
Two rows of 5 heads carved in a circle around
the pole, the lower row upside down
2. gipe'i gnum gana'-o flying frog
on pole, robe Ness myth
3. xpiqil's'n or xpuqul's'n "three across
across them"

A woman of this house was adopted into
ksangitqig'e'nix and took this crest with her.

Shown as 3 carvings: 2 house posts? half man half
woman? and frog.
