July 9 appeared to have some authority over the rest, though
1787 he had nothing to dispose of: he gave us to understand,
that in another part of these islands, (pointing to the
Eastward) he could procure plenty of furs for us, on which
Captain Dixon gave him a light horseman's cap: ---
(others obviously envied him).

July 29 18 canoes 200 people alongside, including "the Old Chief, whom
we had seen on the other side of these islands, and who now
p. 217 appearing to be a person of the first consequence, Captain
Dixon permitted him to come aboard." He had lost his
cap in a fight, Dixon gave him another one.
