Village of 65 houses old & new. Collected for Smithsonian
Collected tusks of babyroussa or Aenatic wild hog
in grave of old skaga dead over 50 yrs p 141

Aug 6 left for North Island with "Edinso", chief of
North Island --- formerly lived at a village called
p 142 Kioosta - 4-

Kioosta - 6-14th: Burial caves full.

Her camp at Kioosta village is a mausoleum
or burial house of old Doctor Koontz, a famous
skaga or shaman, who died many years ago --- "In his
p 143 grave I found the tusks of the babyroussa mentioned"

Aug 14 - sailed around C Knox

Aug 17 Tiedoo near Suck or Frederick Island

"There were a few Indian houses --- vacant --- occ
p 144 during the season by sea-otter hunters.

"old Edinso, excellent pilot

Aug 26 Skidgate Oil Company

Laskook new octastyle house, by dongs to take place there

p 145 later in fall

Koona village, the residence of Captain Skidance, the
