- 1 Colonel Apr 6 '61 p3 Attempt to murder a police officer
- 2 Aug 7 '61 p3 Falling from grace
- 3 June 26 '97 p6 Worthy Haida chief [obit. by Harrison]

2 above Yesterday Edenshaw the famous Haida chief - lately commissioned to act as policeman at the northern Indian encampment got drunk - fought another Indian - cut & lacerated - took leave commission today.

1. above Edenshaw - chief - tried to shoot Sgt Blake in the jail yard yesterday.

 1864
 Some years ago Capt. James Kirk was wrecked on the HBC ship Vancouver, and went ashore to see Edenshaw - fled cowardly - seized by 4 and stripped. Capt set ship on fire to prevent Indians plundering it.
 Keesom thought Sgt Blake had killed his sectors son - went aboard to shoot him seized. £40 bail. OK.

3 above - about 1842 moved to No Island

James July 2 1952 Haida's Chief Edenshaw sculpted with carvings

 Charles Edenshaw
 In 1907 Alfred Carmichael land prospecting on OCI walked Skid → Masset and found stooped, wrinkled man carrying a tottem

Carmichael photographed him at work (photo with 2 canes in background)

Swanton - used Dawson and Boas 5th & 12th reports. 1889, 1898

- had Chas. Edenshaw carve models for him at Masset (had another carver at Skidgate [where James Dawson had models made in 1891-2])

- his interp at Masset was Henry Edenshaw
 at Skidgate was Morby

Why didn't he use Chas. Eden as interp and informant, as Boas had done in 1897?

Colonel June 12 1862 Good Bye to the Northerners

at Lad. Bay - "Edenshaw, chief of the Hydahs, reported only one sick man in the tribe" 20 canoes of Hydahs, 5 with OC Islanders.
 Subvrat to accomp. part remains for protection.
