Old Mary + Family, Suffered from Herpes was in my house, as we had to make the dining room the hospital. Cured in a month.

Chipwrecked Eskimos. all white men drowned while chasing walrus. They made weapons from old barrels. Hoop, spear heads, staves, bows + arrows. Killed bears by getting them to swallow seal blubber wrapped round whale bone which was bent. When the blubber melted the bone rebounded to its normal shape + the bear in agony would lay down + become an easy prey to hunters.
