

The part is greater than its whole

The act creates its own antecedents } $\frac{1}{2}$
as well as its consequences } $\frac{1}{2}$
- and implies its companion act } $\frac{1}{2}$

The act is being done by the doer to itself
the biter is getting bit (by himself)
the swallower is "swallowing" "herself".
and becoming what she was
and is half way there.

In art the end and beginning are there at the same time
(so bisociate, go both ways equally)

The end is its own beginning

The end comes before the beginning

The bird lays an egg, ^{larger than itself} out of which it hatches

I am inside the salmon I eat

The part is ^{twice as great} ~~double~~ twice as large as its whole

The whole is a half of its part

Crab - comes out of its shell, 3 come out of 1.
One and its 2 halves, both.
