3. saxsa'ox t
4. niasnawe' or t'omno'ox
5. wilaxe'

The Royal Timlaham had a fight over 10 children
The 2 chiefs that came down first and settled at
gitsala'sa were 1. niasnawexs 2. nias taxox'ok
niasnawe was another, came with niasnawexs. The
other royal chiefs came down the river on the same
occasion. One, t'omno'ox found the gilodza.
When eeks found the ginaxangik the chief^{53m2192t} was a
g.anda'do tkulis'ye'n (little monk); this was the
grfa of niaskwale'x. eeks was invited to join
ginaxangik.
