1. Gibbs c. 1855 Chest is classic chest. This definitely pushes the chest style back to 1855 (when CE was 15)
2. Painted paddles c. 1839 have the style

3. Mate Chest TP 1883 } \$40.00 } TP chest better! than CE
" " CE 1883 } \$35.00 }
CE not good so early
4. 1830-40's ^{ship} panel pipes & wood ^{pipe} pipes belong together
USNM has lots of both
5. ¹⁸⁴² Wilkes, ¹⁸⁵⁵ Gibbs, and ¹⁸⁶³ Swan all collected round geometric plates
6. "Shock-ash" carved a nice textured witch.
7. 2 big TP wood painted chests? Swan
8. Dear Mother is small
