Most Mr. J.W. Origin connected with kxəmxsa'n, gitlaxda'mks
 also related to telq.amug, kispayaks,
 same names as xəmxsa'n. Informants don't know ada'ox
 but it is not the same as wimənzək

Crests

1. xskε'k eagle, shown on pole in same
 manner as haq.ε' at Kispox, with abalone
 around neck.
2. tsəme'lix beaver on pole, also robes.
 They have it on a gravestone ready to put up.
3. gi'məxəntu a bird like being. ~~is~~
 This is where haq.ε of Kispayaks got this crest
 (it is on his pole). Five members of this family
 died at Kispox and haq.ε paid the expenses
 of their burial. In compensation ya'a'mts
 the house head gave haq.ε the xskε'k and
 gi'məxənt crests.

wa'lix brought the crest xpigilə'n? from the
 Koss house of xəmxsa'n, also the names of that
 house. This occurred within informants memory. No
 connection between the houses before then.

is also
 wimənzək
 crests

ya'qu was the chief name in the house at one time
 and was an original local gisq.agas, not
 connected with mə'u'ləq. P.D. says same origin as m>l.
